


## Showing How Much Money You Earn

To be part of the program you need to give us proof of the total income for every family member who lives with you before taxes (also called **gross income**). To figure out your family's total income, you need to submit proof of income for all family members living with you.\*

Proof of Income		
<p><b>One of the following:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 1 months' worth of paycheck stubs</li><li>• Federal Tax Return (1040, 1040A, 1040EZ)</li><li>• W2s</li><li>• Unemployment Letter</li></ul> <p><b>AND</b></p> <p><b>If you receive the following:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Rental Income</li><li>Alimony Income</li></ul>	 <p><i>If you do not have paycheck stubs, then you need to provide one of the following letters:</i></p>	<p><b>Employer Letter</b> if you or anyone in your house is getting paid in cash. The Employer Letter must give your current salary and total number of hours worked. The letter must be on employer letterhead and notarized.</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p><b>Self-Assessment/notarized letter</b> explaining how you support yourself financially if other documents do not fully explain your financial position.</p>

\*To be sent to one of Erie's partner hospitals you may also need to provide the hospital additional documentation.
